Two week closure for the US 281 / Loop 1604 Interchange Project beginning Tuesday, July 19, 2011

(San Antonio) – The following turn around closure will occur for two weeks beginning Tuesday, July 19, 2011 and is scheduled to reopen Tuesday, August 2, 2011 for the US 281 / Loop 1604 Interchange project.

July 19 – August 2, 2011 – Turn around Loop 1604 EB to Loop 1604 WB at US 281 will be closed for two weeks

Closure: The Loop 1604 eastbound to westbound turnaround at US 281 will be closed; the turnaround is located in front of the Bill Miller's BBQ restaurant. The turn around will close Tuesday, July 19 at 9:00 a.m. and reopen Tuesday, August 2, 2011 at 5:00 a.m. Traffic that normally uses this turn around will need to use the US 281/ Loop 1604 intersection for turn around ability. Construction crews will need to close the turn around for two weeks to begin drilling for future placement of concrete.

July 16, 2011 - Exit Ramp from Loop 1604 EB to Gold Canyon/ Redland will be closed

The eastbound 1604 exit ramp to Gold Canyon/Redland will be closed on Saturday, July 16, 2011; from 8:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. Traffic that normally uses this exit ramp will need to use the US 281 exit. Construction crews will move construction equipment
