## **Construction closure for the US 281 / Loop 1604 Interchange project**

---

**(San Antonio)** – Weather permitting, the following closures will occur for the US 281/ Loop 1604 Interchange Project.

### **Loop 1604 Eastbound Frontage Road**

**Closure:** Loop 1604 eastbound frontage left lane from Gold Canyon Exit Ramp until Gold Canyon Road Intersection

**Date/Time:** Saturday, January 7, 2012 from 6:00 a.m. and reopen at 6:00 p.m.

**Activity:** Construction crews will place concrete barriers.

### **Stone Oak Parkway Exit from Westbound Loop 1604 Main Lanes**

**Closure:** The closure of this exit ramp has been extended until February 1, 2012. The detour routes remain in place for this area. Traffic wishing to use Stone Oak Parkway from Westbound Loop 1604 will need to either exit at the US 281 / San Pedro Avenue exit and remain on the frontage roads, or exit Blanco Road and take the turn around to proceed east to Stone Oak Parkway.

**Activity:** Construction crews are working to finalize the columns for the US 281 North to Loop 1604 West direct connector.
