TITLE VI POLICY STATEMENT

The Alamo Regional Mobility Authority (“Alamo RMA”) has received, or will receive, federal financial assistance from DOT and the Texas Department of Transportation, and as a condition of receiving this assistance, the Alamo RMA has signed an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d-42 U.S.C. 2000d-4 (hereinafter referred to as the Act), and all requirements imposed by or pursuant to Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally-Assisted Programs of the Department of Transportation - Effectuation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) and other pertinent directives.


It is the policy of the Alamo RMA to assure nondiscrimination in its programs and activities to the effect that no person shall on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, age, disability, or income status be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination or retaliation under any federally or non-federally funded program or activity administered by the Alamo RMA and/or its contractors.

The Alamo RMA Legal Counsel has been designated as the Alamo RMA Title VI Coordinator. In that capacity, the Title VI Coordinator is responsible for implementing all aspects of the Title VI program. Implementation of the Title VI program is accorded the same priority as compliance with all other legal obligations incurred by the Alamo RMA in its financial assistance agreements with DOT and the Texas Department of Transportation.

The Alamo RMA has disseminated this policy statement to members of the Alamo RMA Board of Directors and all of the components of the regional mobility authority. Alamo RMA has also distributed this statement to business communities that perform work for us on DOT-assisted contracts. Such distribution was undertaken via publication on the Alamo RMA web site (www.alamorma.org).
