Construction closure for the US 281 / Loop 1604 Interchange project

(San Antonio) – Weather permitting, the following closures will occur for the US 281/ Loop 1604 Interchange Project.

Expect lengthy delays - if possible use an alternate route.

Loop 1604 EB frontage road

Closure: Loop 1604 eastbound left frontage lane from Trail Crest to the US 281 / Loop 1604 intersection will be closed.

Date/Time: These closures are scheduled between Saturday, November 26 from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Alternate Route: Traffic is encouraged to avoid this area while the barrier is being set. If you are in this area, please anticipate delays on the frontage road until the barriers are put in place for the safety of the driving public and the construction workers in this area.

Activity: Construction crews will be setting barriers in place for protection of drivers and workers in this area to begin the drilling for the columns for the eastbound to southbound connector.

Loop 1604 EB Entrance Ramp from the Loop 1604 EB Frontage Road

Closure: The Loop 1604 eastbound entrance ramp, past Trail Crest, before US 281, will be closed.

Date/Time: This ramp is scheduled to be closed starting Saturday, November 26, at 6:00 a.m. and reopening Monday, November 28 at 5:00 a.m.

Alternate Route: Traffic will use the Loop 1604 EB Gold Canyon entrance ramp or the Loop 1604 EB entrance ramp after Blanco to enter Loop 1604. Or it is strongly recommended drivers take another route.

Activity: Construction crews will start drilling and construction of the columns for the eastbound to southbound direct connector.

Loop 1604 WB frontage lane

Closure: Loop 1604 westbound frontage left lane from Sigma to Stone Oak Parkway (west of Costco)

Date/Time: Saturday, November 26 at 6:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.

Activity: Construction crews will be setting barriers in place for protection of drivers and workers in this area.
