## **Construction closures for the US 281 / Loop 1604 Interchange project**

---

**(San Antonio)** – Weather permitting, the following closures will occur for the US 281/ Loop 1604 Interchange Project.

**Updated August 25, 2011 – US 281 NB frontage lane will be closed**

The US 281 northbound left frontage lane (between the US 281 north entrance ramp and US 281 northbound to US 281 southbound turnaround) will be closed tonight August 25, 2011 from 10:00 p.m. until 12:00 a.m. Crews will place concrete barriers. The US 281 northbound to US 281 southbound turnaround will remain open.

**August 27, 2011 – Loop 1604 EB right lane and shoulder will be closed from Stone Oak Parkway exit to Stone Oak bridge**

The Loop 1604 eastbound right main lane and shoulder will be closed after the Stone Oak Parkway exit ramp to the Stone Oak bridge. The closure will take place Saturday, August 27 from 4:00 a.m. till 6:00 p.m. Construction crews will install new barriers and begin striping.

**August 27, 2011 – Loop 1604 EB frontage lane from Stone Oak Parkway to the US 281 exit ramp will be closed**

The Loop 1604 eastbound frontage left lane will be closed starting from Stone Oak Parkway (in front of the Valero) to the US 281 exit ramp (Afton Oaks). The closure will take place Saturday, August 27 from 4:00 a.m. till 6:00 p.m. Construction crews will install new barriers and begin striping.
