Final Community Workshop Scheduled for September 12

Workshops designed to provide community with understanding of transportation funding and planning

(SAN ANTONIO) – September 12, 2006 – The Alamo Regional Mobility Authority (Alamo RMA) will host the final of five community workshops to discuss transportation-funding issues on Tuesday, September 12, 2006 at South San High School Cafeteria, 2515 Navajo, 78224. The doors will open at 6 p.m. for an open house with various transportation agencies. The workshop begins at 7 p.m. The public is invited to attend.

Participants will have the opportunity to participate in an exercise to learn about and better understand the scope of the region's transportation challenges. The exercise, featuring facilitated small group discussions, is designed to provide the community with knowledge of transportation funding, transportation planning and the role of the agencies involved with planning, implementing and managing the regional transportation system.

In addition, the Alamo RMA will have available - for distribution to the public - copies of information handed out at the recent Bandera Road Public Meeting held on July 27, 2006. The Alamo RMA will provide staff to take comments from attendees on all Alamo RMA projects during the open house portion of the workshop.

This series of workshops have addressed general transportation issues and supplemented information that was provided at project specific meetings that occurred this summer.

In addition to having questions answered by Alamo RMA staff, citizens will also be able to gather information from other transportation agencies.

The Alamo Regional Mobility Authority (Alamo RMA) is charged with significantly accelerating needed transportation projects within Bexar County. The Alamo RMA works in conjunction with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), the San Antonio - Bexar County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and other agencies to provide a tolled lane network as one solution to the overall transportation challenge facing this region.
