Community Workshop Scheduled for July 11

Workshops designed to provide community with understanding of transportation funding and planning

(SAN ANTONIO) – July 10, 2006 – The first of five community workshops to discuss transportation funding issues will be held on Tuesday, July 11, 2006 at the Holmes High School cafeteria, 6500 Ingram Road, 78238. The doors will open at 6:00 p.m. for an open house with various transportation agencies and the workshop will begin at 7 p.m.

Participants will learn about and have the opportunity to participate in an exercise to better understand the scope of the region's transportation challenges. The exercise, featuring facilitated small group discussions, is designed to provide the community with knowledge of transportation funding, transportation planning and the role of the agencies involved with planning, implementing and managing the regional transportation system.

This series of workshops will address general transportation issues and will supplement information to be provided at upcoming project specific meetings which will also be occurring this summer.

In addition to having questions answered by Alamo RMA staff, citizens will also be able to gather information from other transportation agencies including the Texas Department of Transportation, the San Antonio - Bexar County Metropolitan Planning Organization, the City of San Antonio, Bexar County and others.
