Public Meeting for Bandera Road Project to Feature Public Dialogue

On Thursday, July 27, 2006, the Alamo Regional Mobility Authority (Alamo RMA) will conduct a public meeting on proposed improvements to Bandera Road (State Highway 16) from the intersection of Bandera Road and Interstate 410 West to Loop 1604 (a distance of approximately 6.5 miles.)

The public meeting will be held at the Marshall High School Auditorium located at 8000 Lobo Lane, San Antonio, Texas, 78240. The public meeting will begin with an open house running from 6:30 p.m. to 7 p.m. A formal presentation will begin at 7 p.m. with a facilitated workshop and public comment period following.

“The Alamo RMA recognizes how important and vital public involvement and input is in every project we are evaluating,” said Terry Brechtel, Executive Director of the Alamo RMA. “We are implementing a new format which will allow every attendee multiple opportunities to make their voice heard.”

The meeting will feature a brief presentation followed by an open community workshop allowing members of the public to engage directly with study team members. The workshop portion of this meeting will allow for two-way dialogue on possible improvements along Bandera Road.

Attendees will also have the option of submitting detailed comment card responses to study team members to provide additional input, as well as providing comments during the public comment period.

Maps of the project area and other displays will be available for review at the public meeting. Study team members will be available to answer questions.

Copies of all meeting material handouts will be available to the public on the Alamo RMA website, www.AlamoRMA.org, on Friday, July 28, 2006.

Public comment must be received by August 7, 2006 to be included as part of the official record from this meeting.
